The title is somewhat misleading; it could more accurately have been called <i>Aunt Jane's Nieces in Politics</i>. She and Louise have received letters from their "cousin" Kenneth Forbes, the young man who inherited Aunt Jane's estate in the first book of the series. Kenneth has become involved in politics: he is running as the Republican candidate for the local seat in the New York State legislature, but thinks he is going to lose to his opponent. The family decides to go all out to help Kenneth win the election...
